- **The VMware Fusion mass deployment does not work**

If the version of macOS is 12.3 or above, the VMware Fusion mass deployment on macOS fails. The issue appears because Apple removed the support for Python 2.7 from macOS 12.3 onwards.

This issue is now resolved.
