What's New

- The vRealize Operations Management Pack for vSphere Replication 8.3.1.4 provides bug fixes.

Installation and Configuration

The VMware vRealize Operations Management Pack for vSphere Replication 8.3.1.4 software is distributed as PAK file. You install and configure the management pack by using the vRealize Operations Manager interface.

1. Log in to vRealize Operations Manager.
2. Select **Administration** > **Solutions** > **Repository** in the left pane.
3. Click **Add a Management Pack**.
4. Navigate to the **vrAdapterPak-8.3.1.x.pak** file and click **Upload**. When the PAK file is uploaded, click **Next**.
5. Read and agree to the end-user license agreement. Click **Next** to install the management pack.
6. Review the installation progress, and click **Finish** when the installation completes.

After the installation completes you must configure the VMware vRealize Operations Management Pack for vSphere Replication 8.3.1.4 so that vRealize Operation Manager can collect data from the target system. The minimum role required to collect data is the **VRM replication viewer**. For more information on roles and permissions, see [vSphere Replication Roles and Permissions](#).

1. Select **Administration**, then **Solutions** > **Other Accounts** in the left pane.
2. Click **Add account**.
3. Select **vSphere Replication Adapter**.
4. Enter the required information and click **Add**.

Resolved Issues

- **You cannot add the vSphere Replication Adapter in vRealize Operations**

When you try to add the vSphere Replication adapter in vRealize Operations, the process fails with the following error:

`com.vmware.vim.vmomi.core.exception.CertificateValidationException: Server certificate chain is not trusted and thumbprint verification is not configured`

This issue is resolved in vRealize Operations Management Pack for vSphere Replication 8.3.1.4.
